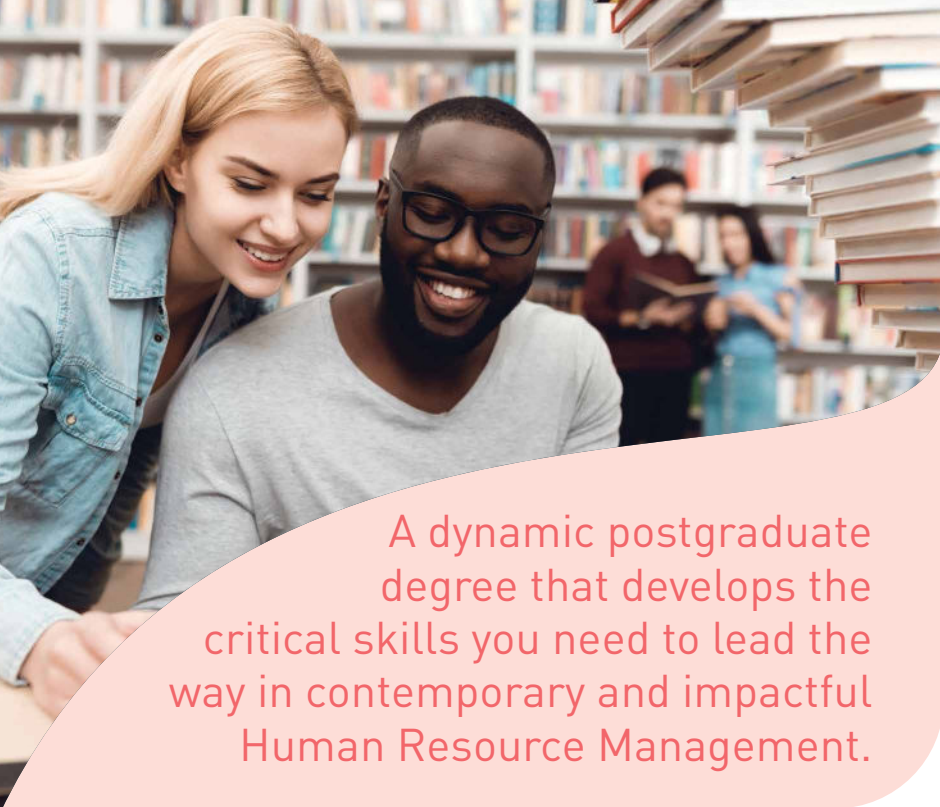

- A minimum of an undergraduate degree with an HRM or Industrial/Organisational Psychology major (NQF 7) having achieved a grade point average (GPA) of 65% and above in all Human Resource Management-related subjects undertaken in the final year of study OR
- Applicants 24 years of age and older who do not meet the above requirements should provide a portfolio of evidence demonstrating formal, informal and non-formal knowledge, training, work experience and/or learning in a cognate field of study equivalent to an NQF Level 7 qualification to support admission to the programme on the basis of Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL).
